They hope to add more children to our Ray of Hope family. In the orphanage they have room for 15 girls, and now have 10. The boy's dorm holds 15, and now have 14. They also plan to add a medical clinic with staff on the base. The orphanage is becoming more self-sufficient and has 600 chickens, whose eggs are sold for profit. They also have a garden with corn, tomatoes, cassava root, eggplant, peppers, Kale and beans, and also mango, orange and papaya trees.
