**OUR MISSION FOCUS FOR JULY**

is the *Clean Water Project In Nicaragua*, sponsored by the Mission Society, South. The goals of the Clean Water Project are: 1) to drill wells in communities unable to pay full cost for a well, and 2) to promote feelings of ownership in villagers who have a well drilled in their community. An average well drilled costs **\$2200**. If KMC could help to support the full cost of a well, or a portion of the cost, we will help to provide clean water for people who get their drinking water from a river or stream, or an open well, which is frequently contaminated.
